WELCOME TO THE PROJECT

Go Inclusive is an Erasmus+ project (2025–2027) bringing together five organisations from Germany, Greece, Spain, and Denmark to make adult education safer and more inclusive for LGBTQIA+ migrants.

Many LGBTQIA+ migrants face a triple challenge: a new country, a new language, and spaces that may not support them. Meanwhile, many educators want to be more inclusive but lack the tools and confidence to do so.

Go Inclusive aims to:

- Equip educators with inclusive language skills to create safe, welcoming classes
- Empower LGBTQIA+ migrant learners by validating their identities and strengthening their sense of belonging
- Produce practical resources for use across all subjects and national contexts

WHAT WE WILL CREATE

Free, open-access resources in English, German, Greek, Spanish, and Danish:

- **Inclusive Language Handbook** – 60-page practical guide with vocabulary and classroom activities
- A structured **Training Course for Educators**
- **Testimonial Videos** with real stories from educators and LGBTQIA+ migrants
- **Storytelling Animations** illustrating inclusion scenarios for classroom use
- **Online Resource Library** with 100+ resources, multilingual glossary, and supportive tools
